

PENINSULA SPCA FOSTER AGREEMENT

The purpose of the Foster Program is to expand and improve the quality of care given to the animals that are sheltered at PSPCA, especially those that are sick, injured, physically disadvantaged and orphaned. This program helps PSPCA to find homes for these “special” pets through your extra care.

The service you are providing by being a foster parent is both rewarding for you and, most importantly, for the pet. We appreciate and sincerely thank you for your time and effort.

It is important that you follow the guidelines below. Failure to do so could result in your removal from the foster care program.

I agree to hold PSPCA harmless from any direct or consequential damages arising out of this foster care agreement and to abide by the following conditions:

1. The animal(s) shall remain the sole property of PSPCA.
2. The animal(s) shall be returned to PSPCA upon request, or if I am no longer able to adequately care for them.
3. I agree to provide food, water, shelter and TLC to the foster animals and to follow all medical instructions.
4. I understand that I do not have any right or authority to keep or place foster animals in other homes or with other individuals.
5. I understand that all foster animals must be confined to areas away from my own pets.
6. I understand that many viruses have an incubation period of 7-14 days, and I understand that my own pets may be at risk of contracting a contagious virus. I accept that risk and the responsibility of treatment if necessary, at my own veterinarian and at my own expense.
7. I understand I must call the adoption coordinator before bringing my foster animals in for adoption.
8. I understand all time schedules for the return of foster pets are dependant upon space available in the shelter. I know that making “room” for my foster animals would defeat the purpose of the entire program.
9. I understand that any and all debt incurred by me on behalf of my foster animals is my sole responsibility.
